Prior learning

Future learning

In Year 2, you will learn about how buildings in London have changed over time as a result of The Great Fire of London.

- Learn about the difference between the past and present.
- Order key events from your past and compare your history with the history of other children in the class.
- Discover the ways historians work and use artefacts to find clues about the past.
- Find similarities and differences between Hackney in the past and present.
